# Our Short-Term Programmes

For students joining us for shorter periods of time (less than the full 2 year A Level programme), they are able to join our existing provision of A Level classes, as well as build an experience beyond with a choice of extra courses and activities to ensure they gain the maximum benefit from their time with us.

Their weekly timetable will be made up of:

- ▶ A selection of **GCSE, A Level** and our GCSE replacement courses, namely the Global Changemaker Programme or the Innovation and Entrepreneurship Programme. These bespoke programmes culminate in being awarded **The King's High Certificate**, and can be adapted for one or two term's work.
- ▶ Within our **Global Changemaker Programme** we offer units on social justice, global citizenship, law and the legal system and climate change. Within our **Innovation & Entrepreneurship Programme** we offer units on data analysis, sustainable engineering, neuroscience and entrepreneurship.



- ▶ **EAL** Group lessons with our Boost Tutors.
- ▶ \*Option to join a **Maths** stream (either Additional Maths, AS Maths or Functional Skills Maths, depending on ability).
- ▶ \* Option to complete an **independent research project**.  
*For students staying one term, this could be an HPQ or the King's High Certificate in Creative Thinking. For students staying for 2 or 3 terms, they could complete a Level 2 EPA (equivalent UCAS points to ½ an A Level).*
- ▶ **Friday afternoon activities**, where students can select from a wide range of co-curricular activities from Amnesty International, art illustration, canoeing and ceramics through to volunteering, yoga and Young Enterprise.
- ▶ **Weekly Health, Fitness and Wellbeing.**





# Historic Warwick

Our beautiful 55-acre campus is nestled in historic Warwick, at the very heart of England. Tranquil St Nicholas Park is opposite, through which the River Avon runs towards Warwick Castle, originally built by William the Conqueror in 1068, and all the amenities of Warwick town centre are within a ten-minute stroll.

During their free time, girls can explore our extensive school facilities or venture further afield into Warwick. The Georgian town of Royal Leamington Spa, famous for its mineral springs (and shopping!), is just a short bus or bike ride away.

Warwick is located in the picturesque South Warwickshire countryside, once home to J.R.R. Tolkien and Shakespeare, and close to many other famous towns and cities including Stratford-upon-Avon, Oxford and Birmingham. You can even be in central London in less than 90 minutes by train.


