### Year 13

### Year 12

Help to develop their employability skills & professional guidance - communication, debating, interview technique, CV Writing, time-management, teamwork, presentation skills. Help them find their element – congruence between their skills, aptitudes, interests and passions and avenues in which they can fulfil these in suitable careers

### Year 11
